### Introduction

The Asia Pacific Chapter of the HTCIA is proud to announce that we are bringing another quality international training event to Hong Kong.

This is a rare opportunity to learn from two of the regions foremost “white hat hackers” whom we are bringing to Hong Kong from Taiwan to share their cutting edge knowledge on new unpublished hacking techniques and defences.

Nowadays sophisticated spyware is harder to deal with, and ‘rootkits’ are becoming increasingly stealthy and intelligent. In this full day workshop, the speakers will discuss and demonstrate the latest trends in spyware and rootkits, including brand new infection and stealth tricks. In addition, they will present their exclusive scanning technology based on spyware behavior analysis, and show how to conduct forensic analysis of spyware and reversing engineering techniques.
